Corvette Tech Tip: Protect Your Cooling System

Your Corvette’s cooling system plays a critical role in maintaining engine performance and preventing overheating. High-performance engines generate significant heat, and the cooling system—made up of the radiator, water pump, thermostat, hoses, coolant, and fans—works together to keep temperatures under control.

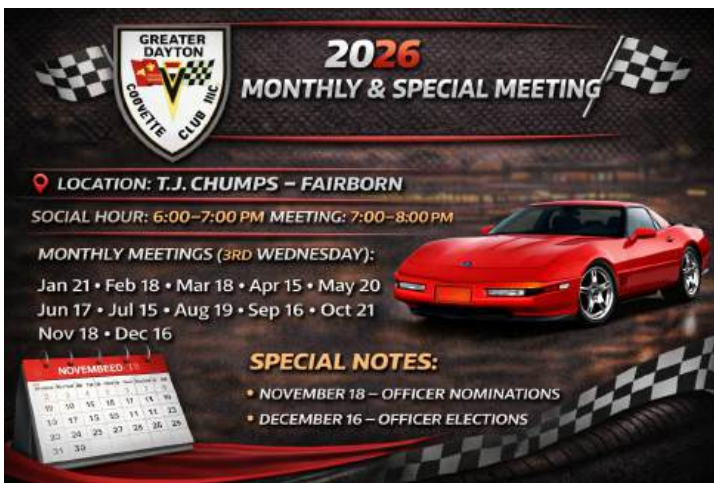
Over time, coolant can break down and collect debris or corrosion, reducing its ability to protect the engine. Routine inspections and maintenance can help prevent overheating and avoid costly repairs.

A few simple checks can keep your cooling system working properly:

- **Check coolant level and condition.** Coolant should be clean and at the proper level when the engine is cool. If it appears rusty or cloudy, it may be time for a flush.
- **Inspect hoses and connections.** Look for cracks, swelling, or soft spots that could lead to leaks or failure.
- **Examine the radiator and cap.** A good radiator cap maintains proper pressure, helping raise the coolant’s boiling point and improve efficiency. Also make sure the radiator fins are free of debris.
- **Verify cooling fan operation.** Electric fans should activate when the engine warms up or when the air conditioning is on.

Most Corvettes recommend replacing coolant about every five years or 100,000 miles, though more frequent service may be helpful for performance driving.

Regular cooling system checks are a simple way to protect your engine and ensure your Corvette stays ready for the road.

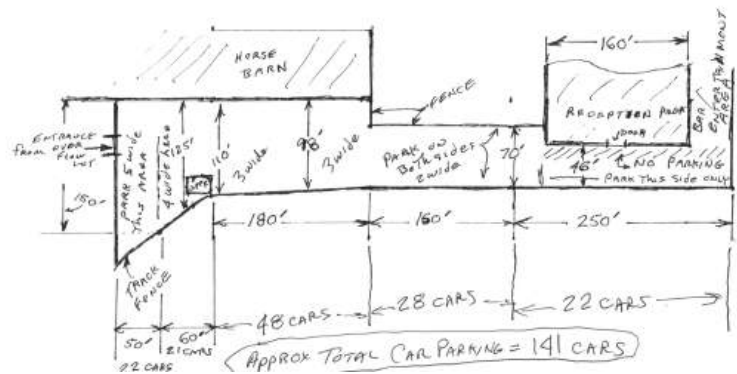

GDCC Car Show Parking Plan – 2026

This year's GDCC Car Show will take place on Saturday, June 20th at our exciting new venue—Hollywood Gaming Casino & Raceway.

After a detailed site visit, Tom Brooks and Dennis DeHaan (Parking Coordinator) mapped out a parking layout designed to maximize space and improve flow. While the new location is more controlled and compact than last year's Fairborn site, it will allow us to accommodate 130+ Corvettes, with an additional overflow lot available for 50+ more vehicles if needed.

Parking Flow & Layout

- Single entry point for payment and check-in
- Vehicles will be directed from right to left, starting near the reception area
- Cars will be parked perpendicular to the track fence
- Parking expands progressively:
 - 1 row (near reception area)
 - 2 rows
 - 3 rows
 - Up to 4–5 rows near the entrance

This structured approach ensures efficient use of space and smooth traffic flow throughout the event.

Volunteers Needed

We need **at least 8 volunteers** to support parking operations:

- **4 volunteers (2 teams):** Actively park cars and manage flow
- **2 volunteers:** Staff the entrance (collect fees & distribute materials)
- **2+ volunteers:** Direct traffic, assist participants, and maintain safety

Dennis will oversee operations and assist with layout measurements as needed.

Communication

We will use **FRS walkie-talkies (Channel 5)** for coordination.

- Bring your own radio if you have one
- Limited extras will be available or shared if needed

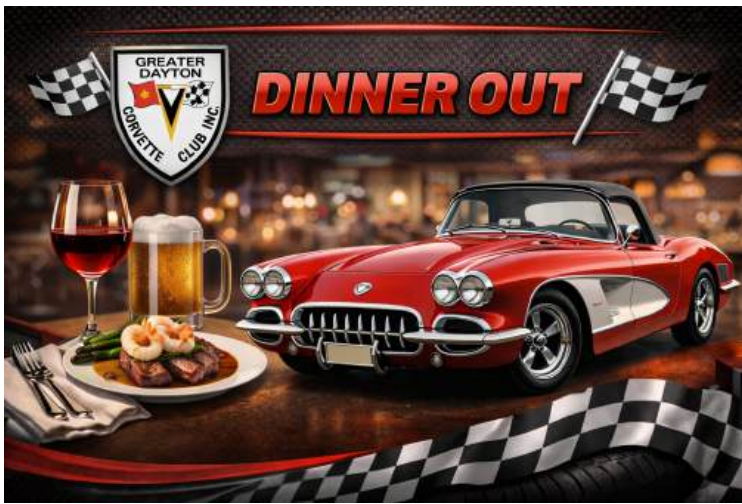
