Hello fellow Corvette Enthusiasts! I am writing to invite you to the QCCC Corvette Show, which will return to the Hendrick Motorsports Complex in Concord, NC for our 15th event. This is a premier show, in that it is the largest single day show in the USA, and it represents the best of the best. Online registration is now open, and I hope that you and your club will join us in celebrating America's favorite sports car!

With hundreds of Corvettes on site, this event showcases all 8 generations and brings modified as well as factory-stock examples to be seen, judged and shared. Commemorative dash plaques and limited-edition challenge coins will be given to all show pre-registrants. Trophies will be awarded for the club with most Corvettes and the club driving the greatest distance to the event. To qualify for special awards, attending clubs must bring at least three Corvettes. There will be many, many more trophies, including Best in Show, awarded for various classes and generations. We will also be holding a silent auction, 50/50 raffle and door prizes, with proceeds again going to benefit our 2026 club charities, Feed NC and Wings of Eagles Ranch.

Show attendees will have the opportunity to tour the Hendrick Heritage Center, which houses Rick Hendricks' personal car and memorabilia collection, and the Hendrick Race Shops, where Hendrick Motorsports manufactures parts and cars for the Hendrick team and more on Friday, October 16 and Saturday, October 17. Tours are limited in space, and these tours sell out quickly, so please make your plans and reservations early. Proceeds from these tours go to the Hendrick Family Foundation charity.

The show will also offer food, drink and various Corvette-based souvenirs through on-site vendors like the National Corvette Museum (NCM) and Hendrick Team Store. The NCM will also have representatives on site with information about the museum. This year, the National Corvette Restorers Society (NCRS) will be bringing a larger contingent, offering printed resources for restoration and preservation. NCRS will also be promoting their new OPEN class for all Corvettes, accommodating both stock-appearing and custom/modified cars as well. Again, this year, we are continuing the well-received speaker/panelist discussion that began last year. Panelists will include some well-known heavy hitters from the Corvette and automotive industry and hobby. If you didn't get a chance to stop in last year, don't miss it this year!
