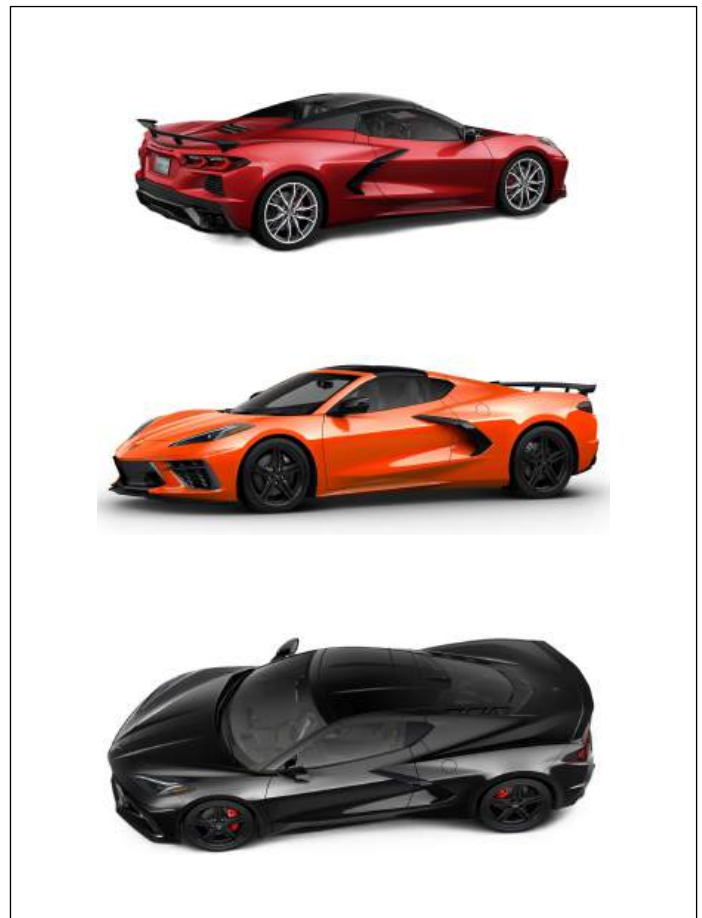

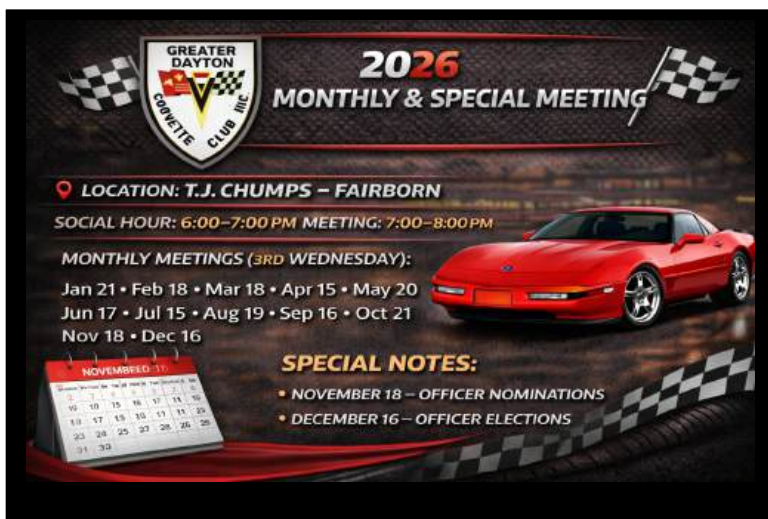

Corvette Tech Corner – Battery Care for Weekend Drivers

Many Corvettes aren't daily drivers, which makes battery health especially important—particularly as we head into peak driving season.

Modern Corvettes have multiple electronics that continue to draw small amounts of power even when the car is off. Over time, this can drain your battery faster than you might expect.

Quick Tips:

- Use a battery maintainer (trickle charger) if the car sits more than a week
- Drive at least 20–30 minutes to fully recharge the battery
- Clean battery terminals to ensure a solid connection
- Replace batteries every 3–5 years to avoid unexpected failures

We look forward to your participation throughout the year as we plan events, celebrate our shared passion for Corvettes, and continue building a strong GDCC community.

A weak battery can cause odd electrical issues—not just a no-start condition—so staying ahead of it saves headaches.

Bottom line: A simple maintainer can keep your Corvette ready to fire up whenever the road calls.

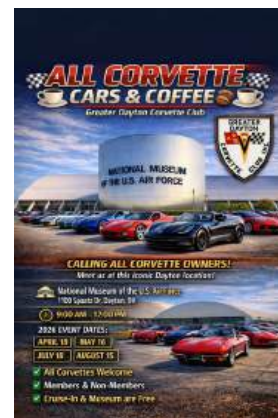
