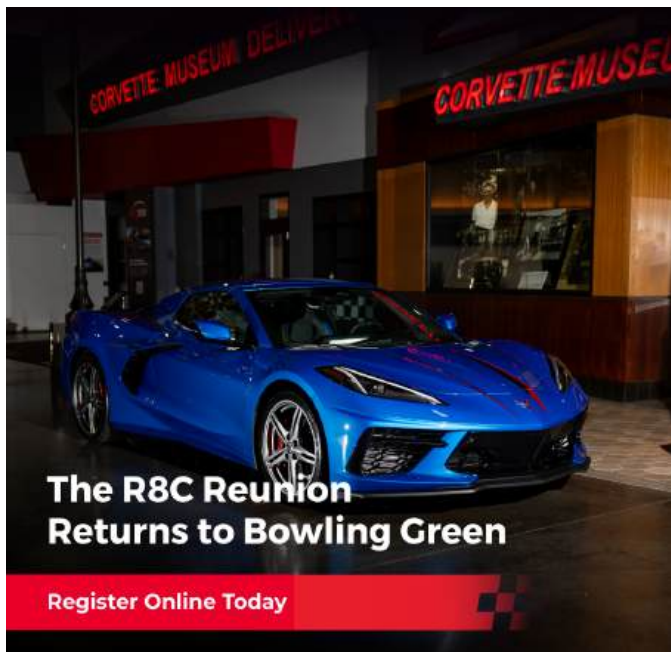

While much of the country marks Memorial Day weekend with American flags, family, and cookouts, those of us with ties to Indianapolis know there's another tradition woven into the holiday—black and white checkered flags and the thunder of engines echoing from the Brickyard.

As a native of Indianapolis, I've always also associated Memorial Day weekend with the electricity of the Indianapolis 500. And with the Chevrolet Corvette pacing the field throughout much of the race's modern era, it feels especially fitting to highlight that connection in this month's newsletter.

The Indy 500 represents the pinnacle of American motorsports. Every detail, from the cars to the track itself, reflects a relentless pursuit of speed, precision, and innovation. The pace car plays a critical role in that environment, responsible for leading a tightly grouped field safely and consistently at speed. It's a job that demands more than presence—it requires performance.

The Corvette has proven itself uniquely suited to that responsibility. Built as America's sports car, it combines advanced engineering with real-world capability. Its finely tuned suspension, powerful engine options, and balanced design allow it to deliver smooth acceleration, confident handling, and dependable control—exactly what's required to guide the field at the start and during cautions.

The modern mid-engine Corvette takes that performance even further. By shifting the engine behind the driver, it achieves improved weight distribution and sharper responsiveness—characteristics that closely mirror those of purpose-built race cars. It's a clear example of how lessons from the track influence the evolution of production vehicles, reinforcing the shared DNA between Corvette and the world of racing.

Yet beyond the engineering lies something just as important: symbolism.

The Indy 500 has long stood as a showcase of American ingenuity and determination. In the same way, Corvette represents the very best of American automotive design—bold, innovative, and unapologetically performance-driven. When a Corvette leads the field at Indy, it isn't just performing a duty—it's representing a legacy.

The Corvette in your garage isn't just inspired by racing—it's part of the story. And every Memorial Day weekend, when a Corvette rolls onto the track at Indianapolis, it serves as a powerful reminder around the world—it not just as an ordinary pace car, but as a symbol of what American performance can achieve.

Because at Indy, Corvette doesn't follow. It leads.

Now, let us embark on a nostalgic journey, reviewing the iconic role of Corvettes at “The Greatest Spectacle in Racing.”

---

### 1978 – 25th Anniversary Milestone

Celebrating Corvette’s 25th anniversary, the Corvette was finally selected to pace the Indy 500. Notably, it was the first pace car in history to use a completely stock drivetrain. Initially, Chevrolet planned just 300 replicas—matching 1953 production numbers—but overwhelming demand led to 6,502 units being produced, roughly one per Chevrolet dealer.



---

### 1986 – Convertible Returns

The Corvette convertible returned after an 11-year absence and paced the Indy 500 for the second time. Once again, no mechanical modifications were required. Rather than a limited-edition model, all 7,315 convertibles produced in 1986 were considered pace car replicas, regardless of the color, with official decal kits provided for dealer or owner installation.



---

### 1995 – Precision Replica Production

For its third Indy 500 appearance, Corvette required only minor safety modifications. Chevrolet produced 527 official pace car replicas, each closely matching the actual pace car’s specifications and options.



## 1998 – Introduction to the C5 convertible

A C5 Corvette convertible paced the race, marking the fourth time Corvette led the field. Chevrolet built 1,163 replicas, virtually identical to the actual pace car aside from required strobe lighting.

## 2002 – 50th Anniversary Celebration

In anticipation of Corvette's 50th anniversary (2003 model year), three early-production 2003 Corvettes were prepared for pace duty, highlighting the milestone celebration. No official production model replicas were made. However, an Indy 500 graphic package was made available for purchase to install.



---

## 2004 – Sixth Appearance

A C5 Corvette convertible (and final year of the C5) paced the race for the sixth time. No official replicas were produced, though enthusiasts have since recreated tribute versions.



---

## 2005 – C6 Convertible Debut

The newly introduced sixth-generation (C6) Corvette convertible paced the field. Chevrolet did not offer replica models for public sale.



---

## 2006 – Z06 Performance Showcase

For its eighth appearance, Corvette showcased the 505-horsepower Z06. No replicas were produced, emphasizing the car's exclusivity.



---

## 2007 – Limited Replica Return

A Corvette convertible once again paced the Indy 500. Chevrolet offered 500 official pace car replicas for collectors.



## 2008 – Dual Pace Cars & Anniversary Tribute

Three Corvette models shared pace duties:

- A Z06 E85 ethanol-powered concept car.
- A black-and-silver commemorative edition coupe and convertible honoring the 30th anniversary of the 1978 pace car. A total of 500 replicas were produced, each personally signed by Emerson Fittipaldi.



---

## 2012 – Fastest Pace Car Yet

A 2013 60th Anniversary C6 ZR1 paced the race, becoming the fastest pace car in Indy 500 history at the time. No replicas were produced.



---

## 2013 – C7 Stingray Introduction

The seventh-generation Corvette (C7) debuted to the world as two early-production 2014 Stingrays were sent to Indianapolis to pace the race. No replicas were offered.



---

## 2015 – Track-Focused Performance

A 2015 Corvette Z06 (Z07 performance package) paced the Indy 500. No replicas were produced.



---

## 2017 – Grand Sport Honors

A Corvette Grand Sport was selected as the pace car, continuing Corvette's dominance. No replicas were produced.



---

## 2018 – ZR1 Spotlight

The introduction of the C7 ZR1 was celebrated with pace car duties and now becoming the fastest pace car in Indy 500 history. No replicas were produced.



## 2019 – Grand Sport Coupe

A Corvette Grand Sport coupe (and final year for a C7) served as the official pace car.



---

## 2020 – Mid-Engine Era Begins

A torch red Corvette Stingray coupe paced the race, marking the Corvette's transition to mid-engine design. It was only the second time a mid-engine car paced the Indy 500 (the first being in 1984 with a Pontiac Fiero). No replicas were produced.



---

## 2021 – Open-Air Performance

A Corvette Stingray convertible led the field, showcasing the versatility of the C8 platform.



## 2022 – Z06 Returns to Glory

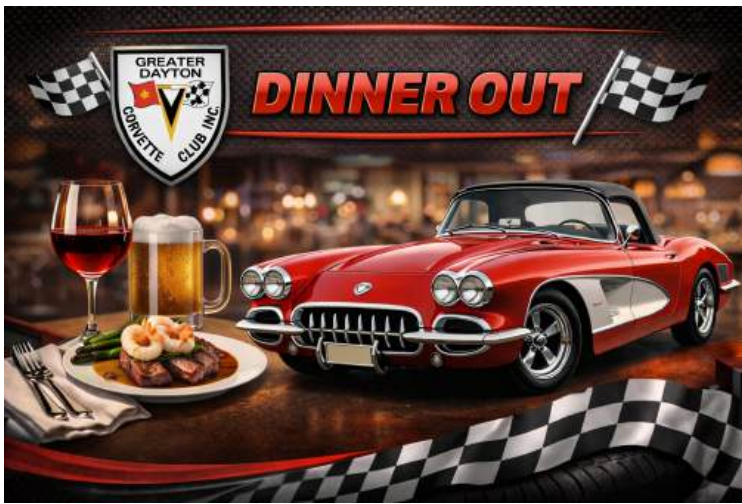

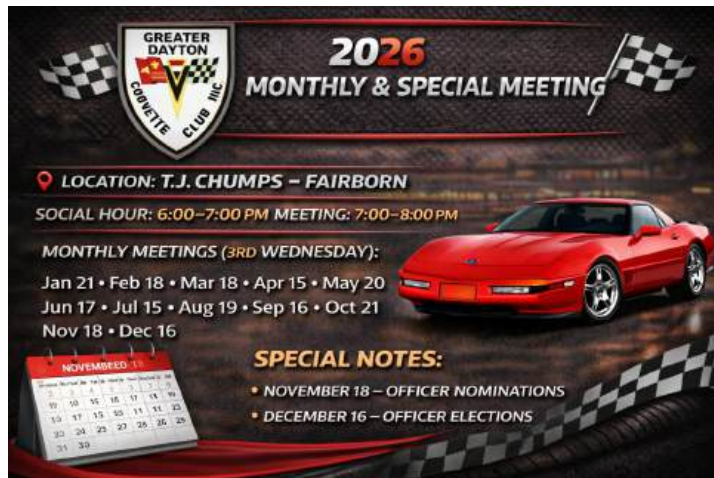

### Corvette Tech Corner – Tire Health Basics

Your Corvette’s performance, safety, and ride quality all come down to four small contact patches—your tires. Keeping them in top shape is one of the easiest ways to protect both your car and your driving experience.

#### Quick Checks That Matter:

- **Pressure:** Check at least twice a month (cold). Proper PSI improves handling and tire life.
- **Tread Wear:** Look for uneven wear—this can signal alignment or suspension issues.
- **Age:** Even with good tread, tires older than 5–6 years can harden and lose grip.
- **Rear Tires:** On most Corvettes, rears wear faster—keep an eye on them.

Don’t rely solely on the TPMS—by the time it alerts you, pressure is already low.

**Bottom line:** A quick tire check before a drive can mean better grip, safer handling, and more confidence behind the wheel.

*Because performance starts where the rubber meets the road.*
